ON ATTACKING PUBLIC MEDIA IN REPUBLIC OF ARGENTINA

We are writing to your good persons and officers on behalf of our great union Radio, Television, Theatre and Arts Workers Union of Nigeria (RATTAWU), which represents workers in the Broadcast and Cultural Sectors of Nigeria's economy, to express our alarm and concern that the government of the Republic of Argentina has negatively intervened in the management of the Public Media Companies (Canal 7 and the Educational Channels Encuentro, Paka Paka and Depor TV), with the aim of privatising, emptying and/or destroying them.
